"The Permanent Sublime: Kant on Terrorism"

The speech offers some introductory notes on the concept of terrorism as it appears in contemporary political philosophy – terrorism as unconventional warfare, as a performative communication, and as a media event. It will be discussed how the notion of war (conventional combat) is situated within the Kantian analytic of the sublime. Finally, the aesthetic categories of the beautiful and the sublime will be placed in a rhetorical perspective, using the concepts of allegory and irony, first via Quintilian, and second, more importantly, via Friedrich Schlegel.
